Welcome to the 2023 Dimension Data Pro-Am

Dimension Data Men's Pro-Am There are two competitions in this event:

72-bole stroke play (professionals only)

Professional players compete against each other for a professional prize-fund, the winner being determined by the lowest overall number of strokes over the four-day tournament.

72-hole Betterball Medal (professionals partnering amateurs)

Amateurs are teamed with a professional partner and together they compete for the Dimension Data Men's Pro-Am trophy and an additional professional prize-fund. Players compete using the Betterball Medal scoring system, in which the lowest stroke of either the professional or the amateur is recorded for each hole. The amateurs' handicaps are taken into account.

Golf courses

Between Thursday, 9 February and Saturday, 11 February, the tournament will be played on the Montagu, Outeniqua and The Links golf courses at Fancourt Estate. Sunday's play will take place on the Montagu golf course only.

Please note: When playing The Links golf course, ensure that you are ready to leave Fancourt 45 minutes before your tee-off time, allowing 15 minutes travel time.

Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am

Together with Standard Bank, we're elevating women in sport at the 2023 Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am. In line with our commitment to creating a more equal playing field, the Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am will be played on the Montagu and Outeniqua golf courses at Fancourt for the first time next year, and sees a significant investment in the professional prize-fund. From 2024 onwards, the tournament will become a Ladies European Tour co-sanctioned event.

There are two competitions in this event:

54-hole stroke play (professionals only)

Professional players compete against each other for a professional prize-fund, the winner being determined by the lowest overall number of strokes over the three-day tournament.

54-hole Betterball Medal (professionals partnering amateurs)

Amateurs are teamed with a professional partner and together they compete for the Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am trophy and an additional professional prize-fund. Players compete using the Betterball Medal scoring system, in which the lowest stroke of either the professional or the amateur is recorded for each hole. The amateurs' handicaps are taken into account.

Golf courses

On Friday, 10 February and Saturday, 11 February, the tournament will be played at Fancourt on the Montagu and Outeniqua courses.

On Sunday, 12 February, the top 10 teams of the Betterball Medal competition will go through to play on the Outeniqua golf course at Fancourt along with the professional golfers, whose scores will carry over for the final round of the ladies' professional tournament.

Golfers are required to comply with the Professional Golfers' Association dress code of long trousers. Players are not allowed on the course in short pants. Shirts are allocated for each day of play.

Golfers' dress code - Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am

Golfers are permitted to wear shorts, skirts or long trousers. Shirts are allocated for each day of play.

orball Medal – Dimension Data Men's Pro-Am

There are 156 Betterball Medal teams, each consisting of a professional and an amateur. The field is divided into three groups of 52 teams. One group contests the first round on The Links golf course, while the other two groups begin at the Montagu or the Outeniqua courses, alternating for the first three days of play.

At the conclusion of the third round there will be a cut to the 20th-placed team. If more than one team ties on the 20th-placed team score, then there will be a count-out to determine which of the teams tying on the cut score qualify to contest the final round. All teams making the cut will contest the final round on the Montagu golf course on Sunday, 12 February.

Betterball Medal – Dimension Data Ladies' Pro-Am

There are 40 Betterball Medal teams, each consisting of a professional and an amateur. The field is divided into two groups of 20 teams. One group contests the first round on the Montagu golf course, while the other group begins on the Outeniqua golf course, alternating for the first two days of play.

On conclusion of the second round there will be a cut to the 10th-placed team. If more than one team ties on the 10th-placed team score, then there will be a countout to determine which of the teams tying on the cut score qualify to contest the final round. All teams making the cut will contest the final round on the Montagu golf course on Sunday, 12 February.

Amateur Handicap Index

In line with the Handicap Index system, your handicap rating will vary by golf course and will therefore be calculated per course based on your Handicap Index as at 1 February 2023.

All amateur players will play off 2/3 of their handicap rating for each course: Montagu, Outeniqua and The Links course for the men, and Montagu and Outeniqua courses for the ladies.

Caddies

Caddie fees are covered by Dimension Data. Vouchers are handed to caddies at the end of each day's play. Please note that caddies are not catered for in the VIP facilities. Please do not give your accreditation to your caddie, as this will cause problems at the security check.

Golf carts

In line with Sunshine Tour rulings, carts are only available to golfers who cannot walk the course/s for medical reasons.

Score cards

Signed scorecards must be handed in at the Sunshine Tour recording area on each course. Spotters record amateur scores on every third hole.

Tournament office

Representatives of the Sunshine Tour will be operating a tournament office in the Fancourt Conference Centre, opposite the Fancourt Hotel entrance.

Amateurs are teamed with a **professional partner** and together they compete **for the Dimension Data Pro-Am trophy.**
